WATER BILL

The water bill comes out once a month, near the first, and will have the past month's water usage on it. You will be charged for water, tax on water only, sewer, trash, & a primacy fee, which is from the DNR for testing the water. Water bills are due on the 15th of each month, if the 15th falls on a weekend, it needs to be paid before. Any bill NOT paid by the 15th will have a 10% penalty fee assessed.

If your bill is not paid by the 1st Tuesday of the following month services will be disconnected and a \$25.00 reconnect fee will be assessed to your account. In order to have your services restored you must bring your account to a zero balance. Meaning, you must pay your past due bill, current bill, and the reconnect fee. Also an additional \$25.00 fee will be charged for after hours, weekend, or holiday reconnects.

If you are moving, please come to city hall or call and let us know when you want services turned off to keep you from being billed further. Also we will need a forwarding address to send the remainder of your deposit back to you.

TRASH

The trash is picked up every Friday. If a holiday falls during the week, trash will be picked up on Saturday. Trash carts must be on the curb by 6:00 am or your trash will not be picked up. If your residence is missed, please call city hall. We offer a free recycling, the recycling carts are emptied every 4 weeks on Friday, usually in the afternoon. Feel free to call city hall, if you'd like a cart or need a recycling schedule. Please do not leave your carts out after pick up.

DOG LICENSE

All dogs MUST be licensed with the city and renewed January 1st each year. There is a \$5.00 fee for a tag for each licensed animal. You will need to fill out an information form and show proof of vaccination for each animal. Should your animal get picked up by the animal control officer, there is a \$20.00 impound fee, and \$5.00 each additional day.

SEMI PARKING PASS

In order to park a semi-truck residentially you must have a parking pass. They are \$50.00 each year. If you do not have a parking pass, you will not be permitted to park at your residence. You will receive a citation and then your truck will be towed at your expense.

CITY COUNCIL

City council meetings are held the 3rd Tuesday of each month, unless it falls on a holiday, and then it will be rescheduled. Planning & zoning meetings are the 4th Thursday of each month. Feel free to come to meetings for any questions or concerns, or contact city hall to be placed on the agenda.

Before doing any construction changes to your property, please contact city hall before you start.
