Mayor King called the regular meeting to order at 6:42pm with the reciting of the Pledge of Allegiance. All Board members were present; refer to sign in for others present.

MINUTES

McWilliams made the motion to approve the minutes of July 19, 2016 with minor spelling corrections. Hackworth 2nd the motion and passed with 4 ayes.

WATER/WWTP

Mr. Keithley was present to give a verbal report; stating that employee Jason Derosier has submitted his letter of resignation. This will be effective August 26, 2016. Mr. Derosier will be taking vacation the week of Aug. 5-9 so physical last day would be September 2, 2016.

Hackworth made the motion to put out advertisement for job opening. Hackworth then amended his motion to include to advertise in both papers and to have starting pay at \$9.50 per hour, also to allow for Mr. Keithley to hire with Board approval on September 20th meeting. McWilliams 2nd the motion and passed with 4 ayes.

Kaufman made the motion to approve the Directors Report and Adjustment Report of (\$40.64). Hackworth 2nd the motion and passed with 3 ayes.

STREETS/PARKS/GROUNDS

Mr. Keithley informed the Board that a quote for the microseal has come in.

Hackworth made the motion to contact Donelson Construction to micro seal the streets of Nola and Loyal for a total of \$30,054.64 and with contractor to notify citizens on those streets for removal of vehicles from the roadway. McWilliams 2nd the motion and passed with 4 ayes.

PLANNING & ZONING – No new business at this time

POLICE – written

Chief Bruce informed the Board that he would be taking an active shooter class “ALICE” to become an instructor. The Clever R-V School is paying for half of the class.

Christian County administration is asking that all municipalities participate in Law Enforcement Appreciation by the passing of a proclamation.

Kaufman made the motion to pass the “Law Enforcement Appreciation” Proclamation. Hackworth 2nd the motion and passed with 4 ayes.

Chief Bruce informed the Board that he was looking into the school zone areas to determine where they need to be placed on such City streets to control traffic flow and prevent hazardous driving conditions. Per Chief's request City Clerk drafted an ordinance to depict such areas.

Hackworth made the motion for the first reading of Bill 06-16 Ordinance 469 “AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 320.030 AND SCHEDULE I OF THE CITY OF CLEVER CODE BOOK” with copies available to the public. Kaufman second the motion and passed by roll call vote: McWilliams – Aye, Hackworth – Aye, Pearce – Aye, Kaufman – Aye.

After review of the ordinance discussion took place of the time and with early out on Fridays. Kaufman made the motion to table Bill 09-16 Ordinance 469; Speed Zones until the next meeting so the time can be corrected to 1:00 pm. Hackworth 2nd the motion and passed with 4 ayes.

After discussion on letters of interest and rates of pay Mayor King made the appointment of Matthew Owen to the position of Municipal Judge.

Kaufman made the motion to accept Mayor Kings appointment of Matthew Owens. Hackworth 2nd the motion and passed with 4 ayes.

Hackworth made the motion to approve the tax levy for the City of Clever for .6212. Pearce 2nd the motion and passed with 4 ayes.

ADMINISTRATION

Kara Kaufman submitted her letter of resignation of West Ward Alderman due to no longer living within the City limits of Clever. Mayor King accepts the resignation, thanks her for her service, and wishes her well.

Hackworth made the motion to adjourn at 7:55pm. McWilliams 2nd the motion and passed with 3 ayes.
